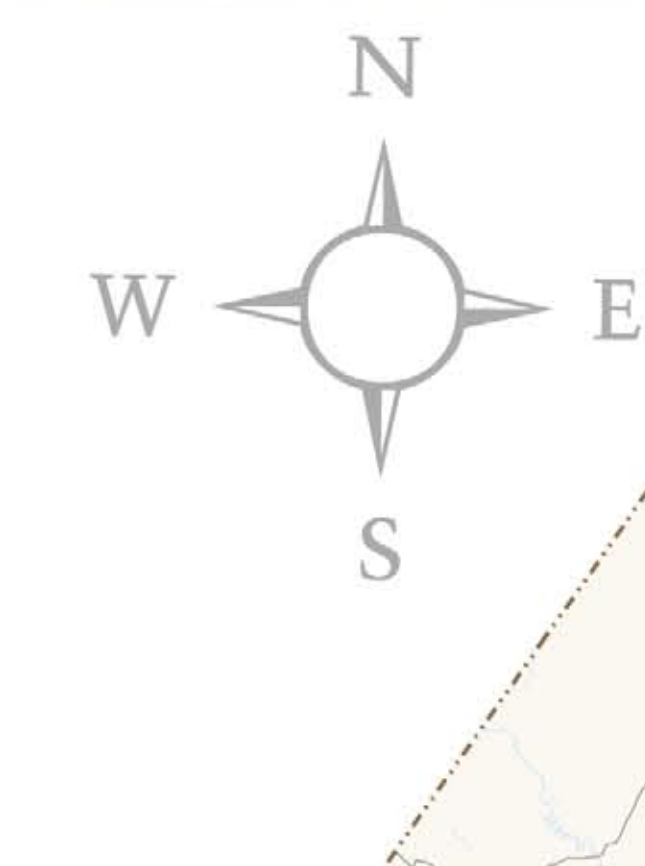
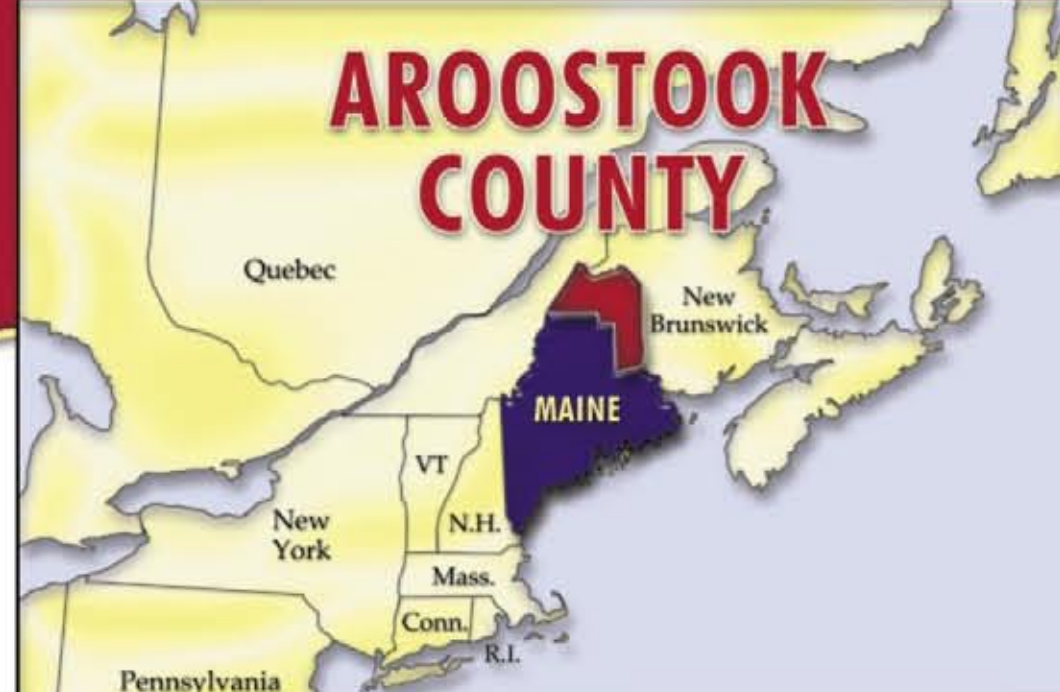

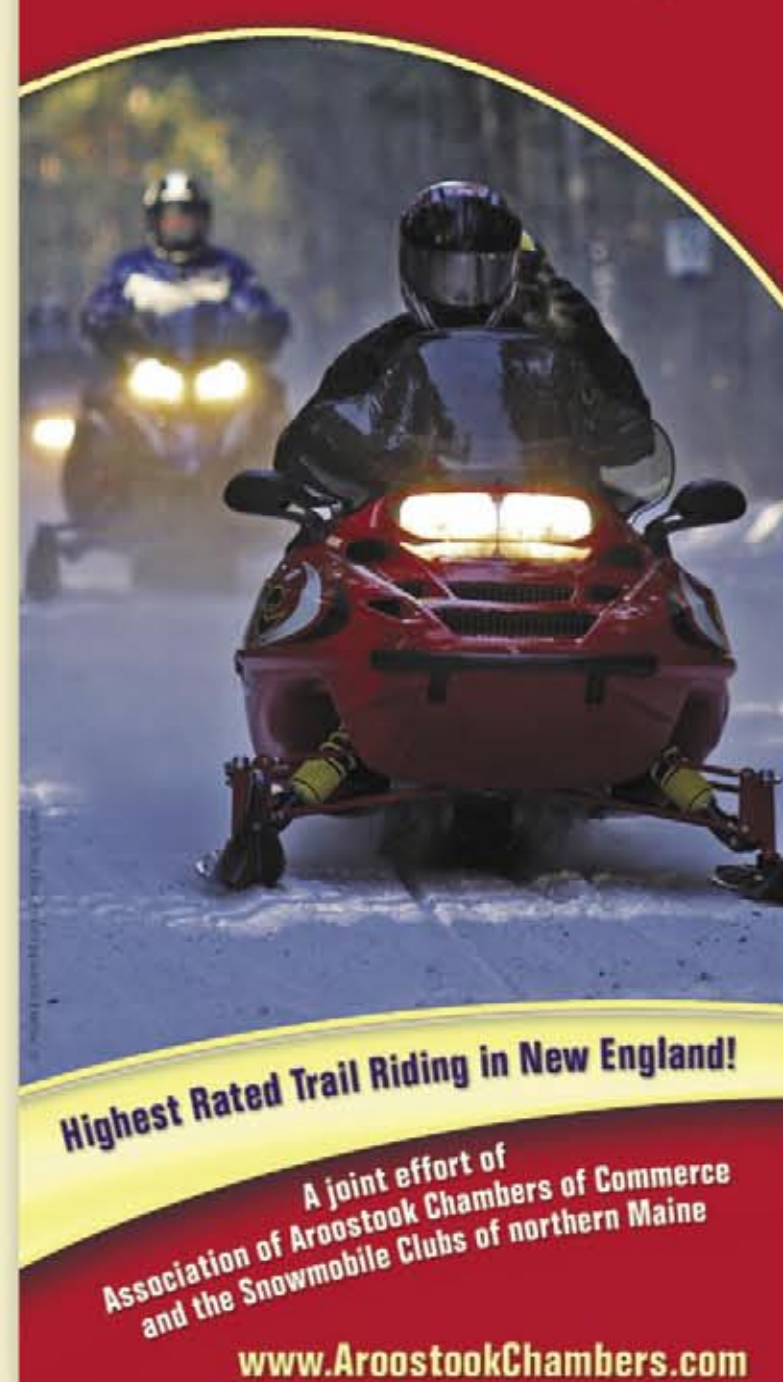

Vacationing in northern Maine is an unparalleled four-season experience. The majestic landscape can be enjoyed by snowmobile in the winter, or by mountain bike, ATV, horseback, or foot in spring, summer and fall. Designated areas of the snowmobile trail system may be used for hiking, mountain biking, horseback riding, or all terrain vehicles.

In winter, more than 2,000 miles of highly rated, wide, well-groomed snowmobile trails include converted railroad beds, abandoned logging roads and a magnitude of club trails, while others traverse power lines up and over large, rolling hills that capture the picturesque beauty of the landscape.

More than 40 snowmobile clubs keep the trail system in top-notch condition. Clubs also spend many hours cutting brush, building bridges, maintaining signage, and working to maintain a superior trail system. Local club trails provide snowmobilers with a variety of scenic rides from which to choose, whether it be a long loop ride, short scenic jaunt, or a trip through the entire County. Aroostook County also offers phenomenal accessibility via snowmobile to gas, food, lodging, service and parts.

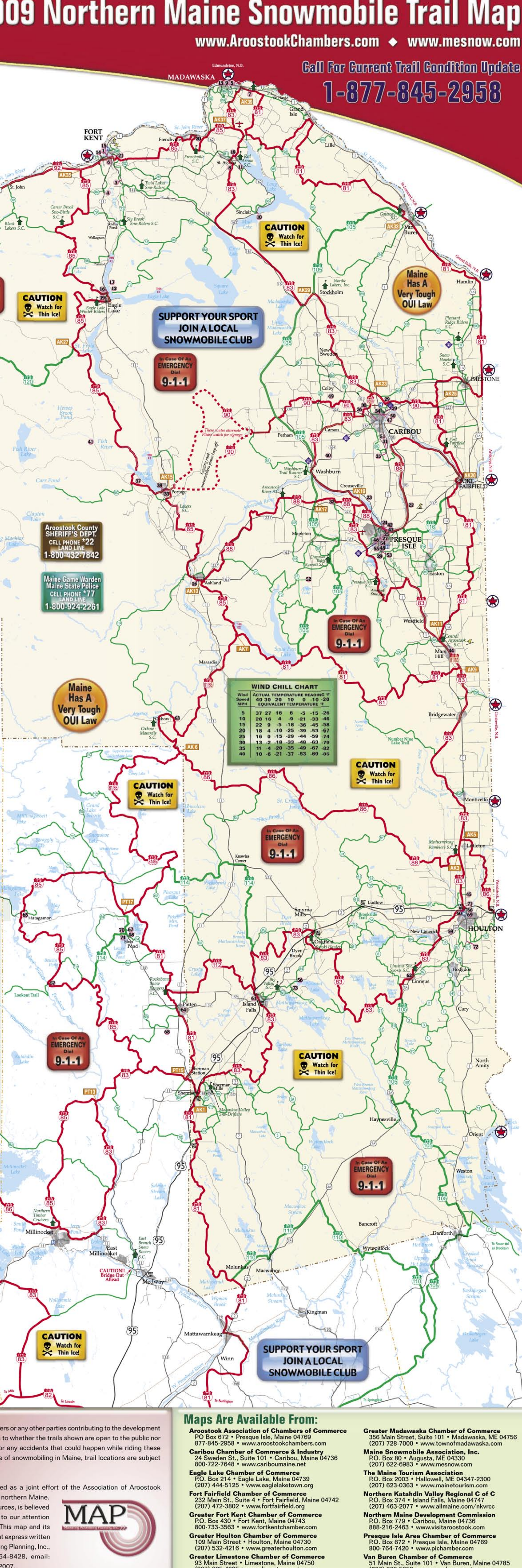
